RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: **Expansion of Transitional Jobs Program to focus on District 4**

Amount of City Funding Required: **\$50,000**

Two of the most difficult problems our city faces is rising homelessness and illegal dumping. The Mayor's transitional jobs program attempts to address both by providing homeless residents with a path towards stability by employing them to pick up garbage off our streets and beautify our city.

This promising program deserves to be expanded. Fifty thousand dollars is requested in this budget cycle to establish a team dedicated to patrolling and picking up garbage weekly in District 4, focusing on hot spots such as Commodore Park, Notting Hill, Berryessa Ave, and Alviso.
