Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

Fund a coordinator/analyst position in the SJPD that would support the work of the South Bay Coalition on Human Trafficking. The San Jose Police Department is in the process of extending the current Agreement with Community Solutions, acting as the Fiscal Agent for South Bay Coalition to End Human Trafficking, in order to extend the support of the coordinator position for one additional year using \$50,000 that was allocated in the 2014-2015 Adopted Operating Budget. This is expected to fund the coordinator position at up to 35 hours per week for the period of April 2015 through April 2016. Additionally, the Department, in cooperation with the Coalition, have applied for a federal grant, totaling \$750,000 that will specifically dedicate resources over the course of two years to combat Human Trafficking. The Department will be coming forward with a Manager's Budget Addendum outlining proposed Human Trafficking resources and activities.

This funding would extend the contract from April to June 2016 and increases hours per week from 35 to 40.
