How can I reduce solid waste costs during the COVID-19 event?

Reduce service level container size and/or frequency. Please contact Republic Services at http://local.republicservices.com/site/santa-clara-ca/customer-support or (408) 432-1234 to discuss pausing your service and any billing concerns you may have. We cannot guarantee reimbursement for solid waste not collected, but we encourage all businesses to contact Republic to decrease or pause service. During this "Temporary Service Interruption" Republic will not remove your containers, so ensure they are in a secured area or locked.

What are some other resources available to me?

 <u>SCORE</u> are available to help prepare loan paperwork.

 businesses, non-profits, and workers impacted by COVID-19 can ask questions. The OED staff will
 work to respond quickly with the information and resources currently available.
