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City of San José, County of Santa Clara, and Verily Announce Progress On Mobile Testing Site and COVID-19 Testing in San Jose

What:	The City of San José and County of Santa Clara will host a press conference on Wednesday, May 20, to announce that free COVID-19 testing is now available for all residents, asymptomatic or otherwise, at PAL Stadium in East San José and the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds.

Details:	Screening and testing are offered at no cost to individuals as a service of the State of California in collaboration with Verily, an Alphabet company. To be eligible, residents must be 18 years or older and electronically sign a COVID-19 Public Health Authorization Form and Lab Consent. Residents can use the Baseline COVID-19 Program online screener and appointment scheduling system at www.projectbaseline.com/COVID19 to screen their symptoms and make an appointment for testing. The website is available in English and Spanish. Councilmember Carrasco will offer interviews/translations in Spanish, and Councilmember Diep will offer interviews/translations in Vietnamese.
