Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (Please describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

In his June 2019 Budget Message, Mayor Liccardo approved the \$80,000 requested by Councilmember Khamis to begin equipping our neighborhoods with supplies needed in a disaster. The Office of Emergency Management began working on plans for purchasing and deploying the equipment but was interrupted by the COVID-19 crisis.

A plan has been developed, however, the demands on OEM are still high enough that implementing the plan before the end of the 2019/2020 fiscal year is not possible. The Red Cross has admitted that they have not had enough volunteer support to tended to the ARKs in their care, and some are rat-infested, with the contents rendered unusable.

While the estimated need is over \$800,000 according to last year's BD, this \$80,000 represents a step forward in having some basic supplies available in each Council District should a major disaster befall our City.
