Families must meet all eligibility criteria below for MVP.

<p>Residency in or around San Jose and/or Santa Clara County during previous 90 days</p> <p>(Only 1 of the preferred documents from this section is needed)</p> <p><i>Exception: families fleeing domestic violence and have a referral from a DV agency</i></p>	<p>Referral form from homeless service provider program</p> <p>Personal mail</p> <p>Children's school or day care enrollment</p> <p>Award letter from County benefits</p> <p>PGE/utility bill</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If client is sent by a referring agency, LifeMoves will review referral documentation and/or HMIS to confirm eligibility Families with children under age five will be prioritized over families with older children,
<p>Family must be literally homeless</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Living outdoors Living in a vehicle Place not meant for human habitation 	<p>Referral form from homeless service provider program</p> <p>Homelessness verification form from the County or homeless services program</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Families from San Jose and Santa Clara County will be prioritized over families from other jurisdictions
