

Motel Voucher Program (MVP) for Families

Families must meet all eligibility criteria below for MVP.

Family with a child under the age of 18. Family with adult dependent child. Residency in or around San Jose and/or Santa Clara County during previous 90 days	Referral form from homeless service provider program Personal mail
