RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted, to enhance Code Enforcement during night time hours.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: Pilot Program to Provide Additional Code Enforcement Officers for Night Time Hours

Amount of City Funding Required: \$250,454 for FY 2014-15, \$199,626 ongoing

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): Medical Marijuana Fees

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

This budget proposal requests 2 full time Code Enforcement Officers to address code enforcement concerns occurring during the hours of 4 p.m. to 12 a.m., relating to marijuana establishments, illegal entertainment businesses and general night time code-related activity. This request covers the cost of 2 FTEs and needed equipment such as a laptop, cell phone service, vehicles and other supplies. This proposal is a one-time pilot program and at the end of the year Staff is requested to return with an analysis of the effectiveness of this staffing strategy.
