RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: GUADALUPE TRAIL PROJECT

Amount of City Funding Required: \$200,000

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): <u>City-Wide Parks Capital Fund (Capital Budget Page V-471)</u>

<u>Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):</u>

The Guadalupe River Trail Master Plan will prepare for a 5-mile paved trail system from Chynoweth to Virginia. Four Councilmember's (10, 9, 6, 3) have committed to \$100,000 of their C&C funds to pay for the full cost of the study. Because trail connectivity provides a true city-wide benefit, I propose reducing the per-district allocation to \$50,000 and funding the remaining 50% of the master plan from the City-Wide Parks Fund. With a healthy ending fund balance, this will allow additional projects to be completed in each of our districts, while still meeting the same goal of a better connected trail system.

The District 9 allocation of \$50,000 is funded from the District 9 rebudget.
