A. Budget Forecast – Jim Shannon presented information on how small input changes can make big impacts on the City's General Fund resources, and modeled information of retriment impacts on the Five-Year Forecast and examples of forecast sensitivity regarding the Discount Rate.

A. Public Pension Plan Amoritization Schedules and Assumptions- Bill Hallmark presented an overview of the City's pension funding, and information related to funding targets, impacts of assumptions, amortizations methods, and types of amoritizations. Mr. Hallmark discussed in depth the City's layered fixed period amoritization and modeled Tier 1 Police & Fire and Federated amoritization payments, Tier 1 UAL and projected payments, projected contribution amounts, and projected variability in contributions. Mr. Hallmark also discussed dedicated contribution streams and had a dynamic chart that was able to immediately reflect how additional annual contributions would affect the UAL in each retirement plan.
