#### **Consent Calendar**

A. Approval of Minutes - Susan Devencenzi made a correction regarding John Tucker's attendance at the November meeting. - A. Introductory remarks on dedicated revenue streams
  - 1) Keith Brainard, Director of Research for the National Association of State Retirement Administrators provided information about other retirement plans use of dedicated revenue streams and additional sales taxes to provide funding for retirement plans. Mr. Brainard also provided information regarding pension obligation bonds.
  - 2) Presentation on Dedicated Revenue Sources
    - <u>Presentation</u>
    - Jim Shannon, Budget Director for the City of San Jose, provided a presentation about how a dedicated revenue stream would impact the City's general fund. In addition, Mr. Shannon provided examples of revenue streams already used in the general fund and other agencies who have approved additional revenue streams in the form of sales and property tax
    - Discussion on this item included points made by Mayor Sam Liccardo, Councilmember Dev Davis, Councilmember Pam Foley, and Councilmember Raul Peralez about the difficulty of the electorate approving additional taxes because of their experience with other tax measures.
