

General Plan Amendment to change the land use designation from Combined Industrial/Commercial (CIC) to Heavy Industrial (HI) and a General Plan Text Amendment to the Communications Hill Specific Plan, a Planned Development Zoning to rezone from Industrial Park Planned Development Zoning District (IP/IP(PD)) to Heavy Industrial Planned Development Zoning District (HI(PD)), and a Planned Development Permit to expand, modernize and streamline the existing concrete and asphalt recycling, manufacturing and distribution facility on an approximately 22.18-gross acre site.
