PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Project Name: San Jose Senior Living Project

File No.: CP20-013

Description: Conditional Use Permit to allow the demolition of an approximately 44,488-square foot building and the removal of 23 ordinance-size trees for the construction of an approximately 195,840-square foot assisted living facility with 195 rooms on an approximately 3.57-gross acre site. 29 of the units would be for memory care while the remaining 166 units would be for assisted living. Project construction is estimated to take 18 months.

The project site is not present on any list pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code.
