Human-centered design is a powerful tool to impact people at scale. We are looking for people who are curious, want to learn new skills, and create solutions that impact San José.

What to Expect.

The City of San José Powered by People 2.0: Learning Lab is a development experience designed to foster a culture of innovation and creative problem-solving. In a team-based approach (organized by five challenges) this gives participants the opportunity to solve a meaningful challenge in the City in collaboration with department leadership to design, test, and prototype a solution. Along the way, participants will receive training in human-centered design mindsets, tools, and techniques.

Requirements.

- Supervisor approval
- Passed probationary period
- 1 year of experience in the City of San José
- 5 Labs + 1 Demo Day from February to April 2021
- 4-8 hours per week - in addition to typical work
- Nonexempt employees will need to agree with their supervisors, about the use of flextime and over time that would allow an employee to fully participate in the learning lab.
