Location: 1591 Senter Road, San José, CA 95112
Size: 75,900 sq ft
Uses: Firefighter training grounds, classrooms, backup Fire Department dispatch and operations center and the City of San Jose's emergency operations center

New Facility's Features



Training Grounds

- Six-story fire training tower
- Four-story apartment tower and two-story residential tower
- Seven-story repelling deck
- Big box store/warehouse tower and strip mall mock up
- Stuck elevator prop
- Mock PG&E power lines
- Vehicle extrication area



Buildings

- Locker rooms, classrooms, and office space
- Commercial kitchen and food serving area
- Garage for fire training apparatus
- Wellness room



Community Benefits

- Replaces the current facility that was built in 1968 with an innovative fire training facility
- Greater firefighting training capabilities resulting in improved public safety
- Enhanced Emergency Operations Center to support the City's emergency response capabilities
