## Re: Memorandum of Agreement Negotiations for Successor Agreements - 2021

Ms. Schembri,

Pursuant to the Memorandum's of Agreement for Operating Engineers - Local 3, the American Federation of State, County & Municipal Employees – Municipal Employees Federation - Local 101, and the International Federation of Professional & Technical Engineers – Local 21, we are herby notifying the City of San Jose that we would like to begin negotiations for successor agreements.

Additionally, due to the extraordinary circumstances of the last year, the three Unions here have formed a Coalition and are asking that we jointly bargain with the City with respect to major economic issues. We propose that each union will still have our own and separate negotiations for Bargaining Unit(s) specific issues but issues such as wages and major benefits be bargained jointly. We believe that this will also be of benefit to the City as it will streamline the bargaining process and allow for a more efficient process.
