#### **Impact Analysis Report**

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Department of Public Works currently operates and administers four fee programs: the Development Fee Program, Utility Fee Program, Animal Care and Services, and the Use of City Hall fee programs. The Development Fee Program and Utility Fee Program are 100% cost recovery. Both Programs provide support and guidance to private customers that desire to do business within San José. As a key component to the City's Economic strategy, it is critical that these services be appropriately staffed to meet the needs of private industry.

The Department also administers various fees for events at City Hall, as well as fees related to animal permits and licenses, animal adoption, and other animal shelter services. In addition to the four fee programs, it should be noted that the Mexican Heritage Plaza (MHP) facility is currently operated by a private operator; therefore, the fees associated with this facility are not displayed in this document as they are suspended. However, they continue to be reflected in the Schedule of Fees and Charges Resolution.

### Development and Utility Fee Programs

The Development Fee Program is responsible for the collection of various private development-related fees, such as planning application review, traffic impact analysis, plan review and inspection of public improvements, review of subdivision maps, grading permits, geologic hazard clearances, and revocable encroachment permits. The Utility Fee Program reviews, issues, and inspects utility

excavation permits and encroachment permits to utility companies and other agencies.

As described above, both of these programs operate on a 100% cost recovery basis by collecting service related fees (i.e. plan checking/inspection) to offset the City's costs of operating these programs. In addition to providing direct service-related support to customers, the Department also administers fee collection for various City programs, such as utility undergrounding, sanitary and storm sewer connections, Inter-Agency Encroachment Permits, and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) data extraction services.

After several years of decline, development activity continues its steady recovery first seen in fall 2010. In 2013-2014, Public Works fees are expected to generate \$7.9 million (\$5.7 million from the Development Fee Program and \$2.2 million from the Utility Fee Program). When compared to the estimated 2012-2013 performance, the Development Fee Program revenues are expected to be slightly lower, while the Utility Fee Program revenues are expected to remain at the same level. The strong activity in 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 is expected to continue in 2013-2014. In the development fee area, a proposed increase in the 2013-2014 revenue estimate from \$5.6 million to \$5.7 million is based on the recommended establishment of a new Technology Fee of 2% on all public works development permits. This fee is estimated to generate an additional \$111,000, which will be placed in a Development Fee Program Technology Earmarked Reserve.

The 2013-2014 projected revenues, along with the use of a portion of the Public Works Development Fee Program Reserve, are sufficient to support a number of recommended program additions in 2013-2014 without any general fee increases. In the Development Fee Program, the addition of 3.5 positions (1.0 Senior Transportation Specialist, 1.0 Office Specialist II, 0.75 Geographic System Specialist II, 0.5 Principal Construction Inspector, and 0.25 Senior System Application Programmer) and reallocations of 2.12 positions (1.0 Building Inspector Combination Certified, 0.4 Senior Construction Inspector, 0.25 Associate Engineer, 0.25 Senior Engineer, 0.17 Assistant Director, and 0.05 Director of Public Works) to the fee program will increase service delivery from 78% to 85% completion rate within specified time frames. In the Utility Fee Program, the addition of 1.0 Engineering Technician position and the reallocation of 0.25 Senior Engineer position is recommended to assist in meeting the service delivery target of 85% completion rate within specified time frames. A decrease to the Public Works Development Fee Program Reserve of \$318,000 is recommended to offset a portion of the recommended actions. This Fee Reserve will decrease from its anticipated level of \$3.9 million to \$3.6 million in 2013-2014.

While no major development fee adjustments are being proposed, the Department will be proposing seven new fees: Real Estate Analysis/Review Fee; Repair of Street Damage for Excavation of Sewer Laterals; Research Design Fee; Bus Stop Facilities – All Other Facilities; Bus Stop Facilities – Bus Shelters; Curb Cafes; and a

Technology Fee which are discussed below in further detail.

It is important to note that the Department undertakes an annual process of evaluating its fee structure to ensure that the fees charged align with the cost of services provided.

#### Non-Development Fees

The Public Works Department is responsible for the collection of various fees for events at City Hall (and previously at the Mexican Heritage Plaza). The fee structure for events was established to partially offset the costs of operating and maintaining spaces for public use while ensuring that the facility is accessible and affordable for the community. In addition, the Department collects fees related to animal permits and licenses, animal adoptions, and other animal shelter services.

#### Animal Care and Services

In 2012-2013, Public Works conducted a thorough cost analysis of the Category I fees for Animal Care and Services (ACS). Based on this analysis, five new fees are recommended, all existing fees are recommended to be adjusted, and one fee is recommended to be deleted to better align actual costs with revenues in order to achieve 100% cost recovery. However, due to the impact of these fee changes and additions, some fees adjustments are recommended to be phased in over three years to minimize the impact on residents and small businesses.

The Department is currently in process of conducting a two-year in depth time analysis study for the ACS - Category II fee program to differentiate services provided

which are part of the fee structure, services provided as public service (e.g. investigating complaints, removal of deceased animals, and picking up feral cats), and contractual services provided for local agencies. Revenues and expenditures associated with these activities are excluded from this report. A total of \$1.9 million in revenue collections; however, is included in the 2013-2014 Proposed Budget document. The Department will continue its review of the costs associated with these fees and will bring forward updated cost recovery rates and any appropriate fee adjustments as part of the 2014-2015 budget process.

During the review conducted in 2012-2013, some fees are recommended to be adjusted. The Adoption Fees have been re-evaluated to reflect a more flexible approach to adoptions. The specified adoption fees per animal are recommended to be individually set by the Director of Public Works or Designee to better align fees with current demand. The fees may be reduced to encourage the adoption of a specific animal where there has been difficulty adopting out the animal, or increased where an animal has been determined to be highly adoptable. The determination of highly adoptable will be made by reviewing factors such as breed, popularity, age, physical condition, and behavior conditions. Also included are six new fees, some minor fee adjustments, and one fee recommended for deletion.

#### City Hall

Reservable event space includes the Rotunda, Plaza, Council Chambers, and Committee Meeting Rooms. The Committee Meeting rooms and the Council Chambers experience the heaviest usage. In the 2012 calendar year, 1,922 events were scheduled, down 6.5% from the 2,056 events in 2011 for these rooms. The Rotunda had 133 events compared to 120 events in 2011.

#### Mexican Heritage Plaza

On May 24, 2011, the City Council approved a third party operator, 1<sup>st</sup>ACT Silicon Valley, to operate this facility. As a result, fees and corresponding revenues from events at this facility are directly managed and collected by this operator and are no longer collected by the City. However, fees for this facility continue to be displayed in the Schedule of Fees and Charges Resolution should the City resume management of operations at a future time.

# SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED FEE REVISIONS

#### **Existing Fees**

In the Development Fee Program, fee increases are recommended in the Miscellaneous Fees sections primarily to adjust the fees for photocopies. For consistency, fees associated with photocopy activities are standardized across the City to match the department with the lowest cost recovery fee for this service. Impacted fees will increase from \$0.24 to \$0.25 per page for  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" documents and \$0.25 to \$0.26 for 11"x 17" documents.

In ACS, fee adjustments are recommended to all Category I fees based on an in depth review and time analysis study of the fee schedule. An adjustment to the Large Animals Event Permit (formerly titled "Dangerous Animal Permit") from \$300 per permit to \$1,291 per permit is recommended to include the review of medical records of all animals, emergency procedures for the event, an officer to observe the transfer of animals to venue, an initial inspection, and a veterinarian review. In addition, other fee adjustments are recommended in the Animal Permit Fees, Inspection Fees, and Permit Application Fees sections. A complete list of proposed fee revisions by service is located in the Summary of Proposed Fee Changes section of this document and in the tables that follow this section.

#### New Fees

The Public Works Department is proposing several new fees for the Development Fee Program and ACS.

### Real Estate Analysis/Review Fee:

The Department recommends establishing a Real Estate Analysis/Review fee to recover costs associated with the required coordination with the City's Real Estate staff on certain projects. This fee would recover costs incurred for Real Estate services including, but not limited to, analyzing materials affecting title, legal description, and encumbrances on a property; conducting research on the best use of a property anticipated to be vacated by the City;

and developing an estimate of value or requesting an appraisal to be completed on a property. The fee is proposed as a time and materials fee with a minimum of \$1,440 per project.

#### Revocable Encroachment - Curb Café Fee:

The Department recommends a new revocable encroachment fee in conjunction with the Planning, Building, and Code Enforcement (PBCE) Department's Sidewalk Café permit fee. This fee will be collected for purposes of recovering costs associated with permitting the curb cafés authorized by the one-year Curb Café pilot program. This pilot program was approved by City Council on January 8, 2013 and is intended to facilitate private investment in the construction and activation of Curb Café's within the public right of way. The Department proposes to establish this fee at \$600 per curb café. This fee as well as the PBCE fee will be assessed and billed at the time of permit application.

#### Technology Fee:

As mentioned previously, a new Technology Fee to establish a Development Fee Program Technology Earmarked Reserve is recommended to fund technology initiatives for Development Services Partners, such as the FileNet upgrade, AMANDA upgrade, GIS Web Viewer/ Online WebMap replacement, Data Sharing implementation, and mobile inspections. In the Public Works Development Fee Program, the Technology Fee will apply a 2% fee on all public works development permits, and the revenues collected from this fee will be placed in the reserve for future use. The estimated revenue collection from this new fee in the Public Works Development Fee

Program is \$111,000. Overall, the Development Services Partners anticipate collections of \$717,000 to begin funding technology initiatives in 2014-2015.

Special Event Observation of Handling Animals During Event:

The Department proposes this special event observation of handling animals during event fee to recover costs due to the impact on officers monitoring the handling of animals during large animal events and shows, and the loading and unloading of large animals. The number of officers is determined for each event based on the number of animals; length of performance; species of animals; size, location and logistics of venue; and the level of potential danger the animals represent.

### Inspection Fees:

The Department currently has an Inspection fee (1 hour included) and recommends adding the following fees to the Inspection Fees section: an Additional Inspection Fee – additional time (30 minute increments, already on-site) and a Re-Inspection Fee (30 minute inspection, includes travel) to better align fees with actual inspection times.

#### Transport Fee:

The Department recommends adding a transport fee for customers that need to surrender their pets from home and cannot bring them to the animal shelter. This fee will also be applied for euthanasia and disposal for customers that request services from home as this fee will partially cover the cost of an officer transporting the animal.

The Department also recommends the addition of a Replacement Tag Fee for dangerous dogs, potentially dangerous dogs, and vicious dogs and a Spay/Neuter Clinic Appointment Deposit Fee.

In order to properly align the Schedule of Fees and Charges Resolution and the Fees and Charges Report, the addition of the following fees are reflected in this department: Keeping of Livestock Permit, Senior Citizen Discount for adoptions, Repair of Street Damage for Excavation of Sewer Laterals: Resurfacing Inspector and Street Pavement Repair Costs, Research Design Fee, Bus Stop Facilities - All Other Facilities, and Bus Stop Facilities - Bus Shelters.

#### Deleted Fees

The Department has determined two fees in ACS are no longer needed and recommends deletion of the following fees: Special Dog Permit Denial Fee which is no longer used; and the Special Dog Permit Inspection as this is now included with the Inspection Fee (1 hour included).

#### **NOTIFICATION**

This Proposed Fees and Charges Report was released on May 3, 2013, allowing for a minimum of 10 days for public review. Public input on fee proposals will be heard by the City Council at public hearings held on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. and Monday, June 10, 2013, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.
