2021 Policy & Program Priorities

Who to Prioritize

- Extremely low-income households (30% of AMI or less)
 - Households at risk of displacement when eviction protections end

Program Design

- Partner with trusted community partners for outreach, intake, and case management to help reach the most vulnerable and hardest to reach
- Outreach to zip codes with the highest rates of COVID-19 cases and/or job loss
- Simple, easy to use application forms
- Simplified payment systems
- Meet federal requirements and prevent duplication

State/Local Coordination

State Program Focus in SJ/SC County

Landlords

- Priority for tenants <50% AMI
- Phase 2: up to 80% AMI

Tenants

- Have lease or rental agreement
- Refer those without lease who are below 30% AMI to Local Program

Data Sharing

Data sharing and dashboards

Launched March 15th

Local Program Focus

Landlords

Refer to State program

Tenants

- Below 30% AMI, and
- Lack a lease/rental agreement

Outreach

- ELI Households via trusted partners
- Connect ARO units, mobile homeowners & park owners, deedrestricted affordable units with State

Launching mid-to-late April
