Monroe Street is a minor arterial roadway with a posted speed limit of 35 mph where speeding is a constant issue with residents who live on that street. The speed radar sign would help to deter speeding and improve pedestrian and auto safety.

\$25,000 will provide for the design and installation of one (1) radar speed display sign on a standalone pole along Monroe St near Forest Ave in the northbound direction.
