

**Installation of the crosswalk will ensure safety for pedestrians who walk from the VTA Curtner Light Rail Station and University Preparatory Academy. DOT conducted a crosswalk study in 2020 along Canoas Garden Ave between Curtner Ave and Masonic Ave; a crosswalk was warranted midblock due to high pedestrian volumes. The crosswalk would be enhanced with Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons (RRFB), curb bulb-outs, a median refuge island, and pedestrian curb ramps.**
