Tisch Way is a collector roadway with a posted speed limit of 35 mph where speeding has become an issue in recent years. The speed radar sign would help to deter speeding and improve pedestrian and auto safety.

\$25,000 will provide for the design and installation of one (1) radar speed display sign on a standalone pole along Tisch near Genevieve in the eastbound direction.
