On the pedestrian pathway of W. William St. and Bird Ave. near the Gardner Neighborhood, nearby residents have reached out to our office over blight and safety issues, including fires that have threatened the homes and lives of our residents. After working with city staff and evaluating the area, it was determined that installing large rocks/boulders would be able to facilitate safer pedestrian access and help prevent fires on the property. Staff has already replaced the fencing and cleared vegetation, and this would be the next step to deter any further concerns in this area.
