On May 18, 2020 we heard from staff that they are beyond capacity on their current workload to address the housing and support services needed for our unhoused residents. I want to thank staff for their tireless efforts in addressing the highest pressing issue our city is currently facing. Since 2015, my office has been advocating for another tool in the toolbox to address the many encampments that happen within our city along our public right-a-way and within our public infrastructure. Knowing that our Housing staff is stretched thin, this funding would give them the resources needed to provide the policy and program development for sanctioned encampments to be considered by the Council prior to assessing any sites as per the staff memo heard on May 18, 2021.
