ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING:

- Be a resident of Santa Clara County
- Be 60 years of age or older, an adult 18 or older with a disability, an informal caregiver of an older adult (60+) or an informal caregiver of an adult (18+) with a disability.
- Have access to an Android, IOS tablet or smartphone that supports the Google Home application.
- Do not currently own a Google Smart Speaker or Google Nest, or similar smart speaker device.
