## PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Project Name: Gschwend Residence Project

**Description:** A Conditional Use Permit for the proposed Project consists of the construction of an approximately 4,464-square-foot single-family home that would be two stories and approximately 31 feet, 6 inches in height and include an approximately 1,441-square-foot attached garage, as well as related improvements including installation of a water well and tanks, a septic system, and a leach field.

Location: The approximately 16.86-acre Project site consists of two parcels located west of Santa Teresa

Boulevard, south of the Bayliss Drive intersection.
