a. <u>SP20-004:</u> Special Use Permit to allow the demolition of five existing commercial buildings, eight residential buildings, and three service structures totaling approximately 14,131 square feet, the removal of 15 trees (11 ordinance-size, four non-ordinance-size) for the construction of two seven-story residential mixed-use buildings, including 173 residential units and 17,836-square feet of commercial space with an approximately 42 percent parking reduction on an approximately 1.34-gross acre site located on the south side of West San Carlos Street, approximately 140 feet westerly of South Buena Vista Avenue (1530 West San Carlos Street) (Urban Villas LLC., Owner). Council District 6. CEQA: West San Carlos Mixed-Use Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR).

ACTION: COMMISSIONER OLIVERIO MADE A MOTION TO RECOMMEND THAT THE CITY COUNCIL TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

- 1. ADOPT A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE WEST SAN CARLOS MIXED-USE PROJECT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT, AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS CONCERNING SIGNIFICANT IMPACTS, MITIGATION MEASURES, ALTERNATIVES, AND ADOPTING A STATEMENT OF OVERRIDING CONSIDERATIONS AND A RELATED MITIGATION MONITORING AND REPORTING PLAN, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA).
- 2. ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING, SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS, A SPECIAL USE PERMIT AND SITE DEVELOPMENT PERMIT TO ALLOW THE DEMOLITION OF FIVE EXISTING COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, EIGHT RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS, AND THREE SERVICE STRUCTURES TOTALING APPROXIMATELY 12,620 SQUARE FEET, THE REMOVAL OF 15 TREES (11 ORDINANCE-SIZE, FOUR NON-ORDINANCE-SIZE) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO SEVEN-STORY RESIDENTIAL MIXED USE BUILDINGS, INCLUDING 173 RESIDENTIAL UNITS AND 17,836 SQUARE FEET OF COMMERCIAL RETAIL SPACE WITH A 43 PERCENT PARKING REDUCTION ON AN APPROXIMATELY 1.34-GROSS ACRE SITE.
