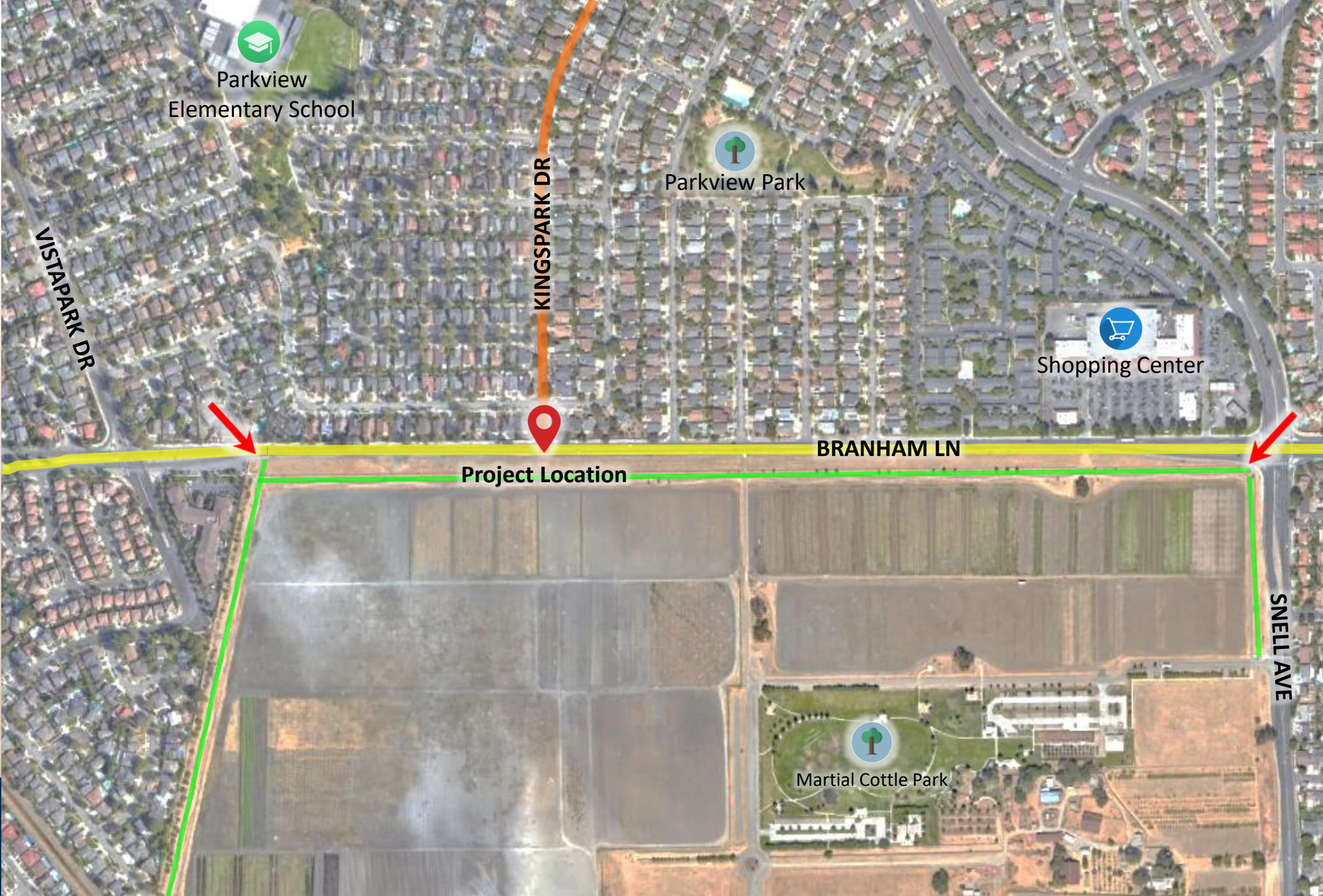

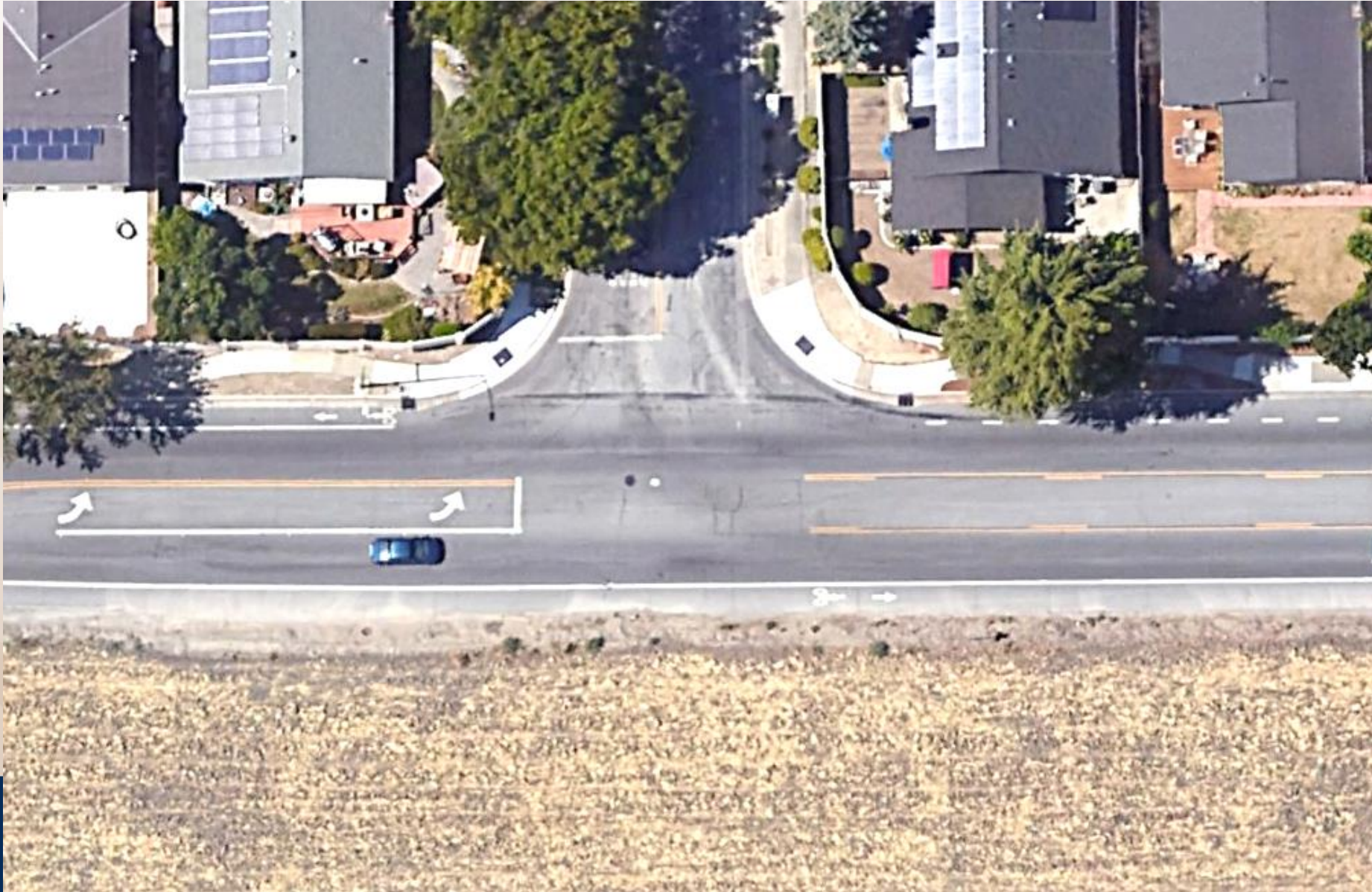
Project Background

- Signal was warranted in 2015, based on State MUTCD standards, and will help address resident concerns:
 - Vehicular access into and out of Kingspark
 - Provide safe pedestrian crossing
- Funding identified in [Mayor's Budget Message FY 19-20](#) (~\$2M)
 - Design and construct new Traffic Signal at Branham/Kingspark
 - Conceptual plans for widening Branham from 2 to 4 lanes

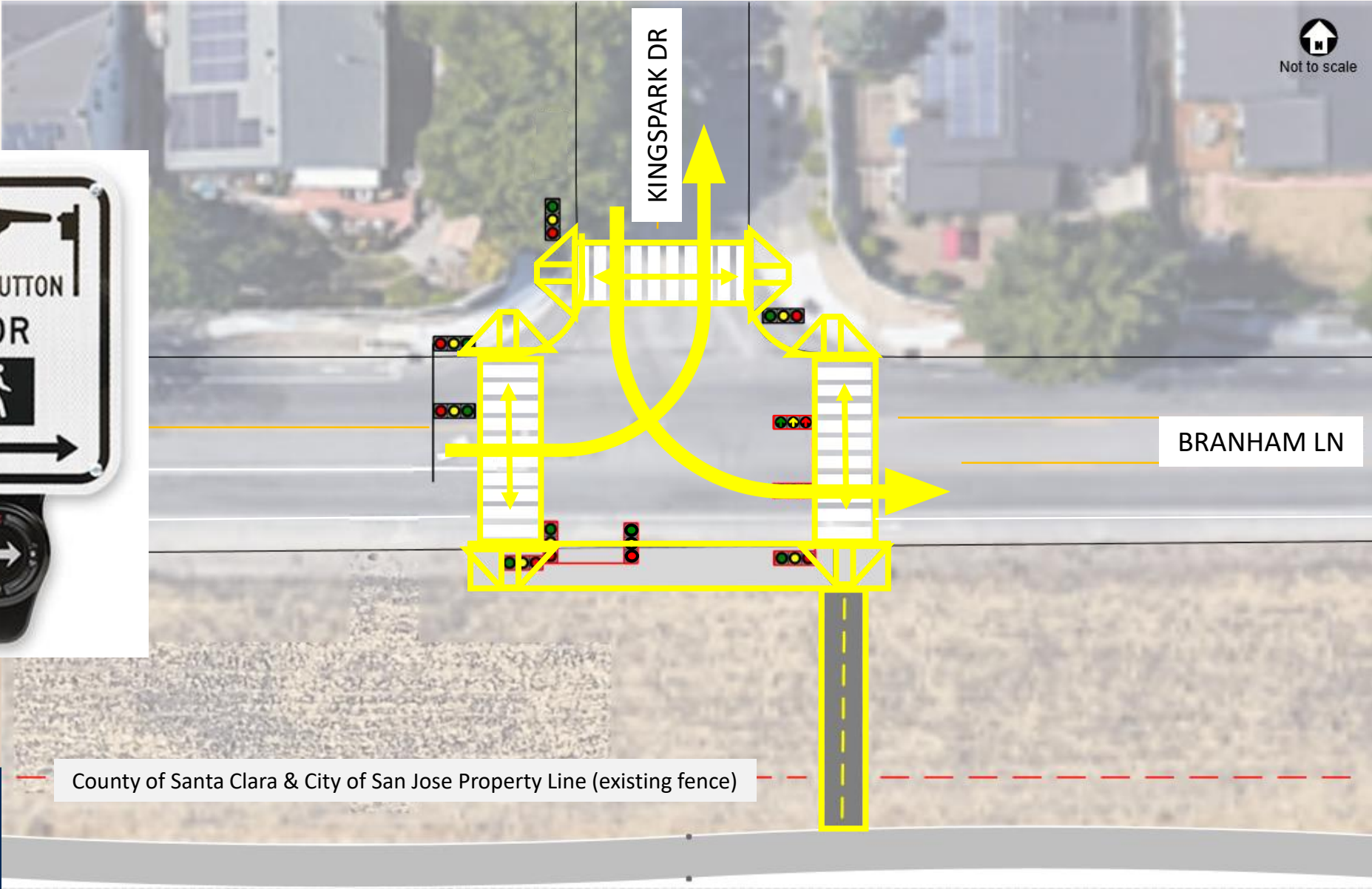
Site Location



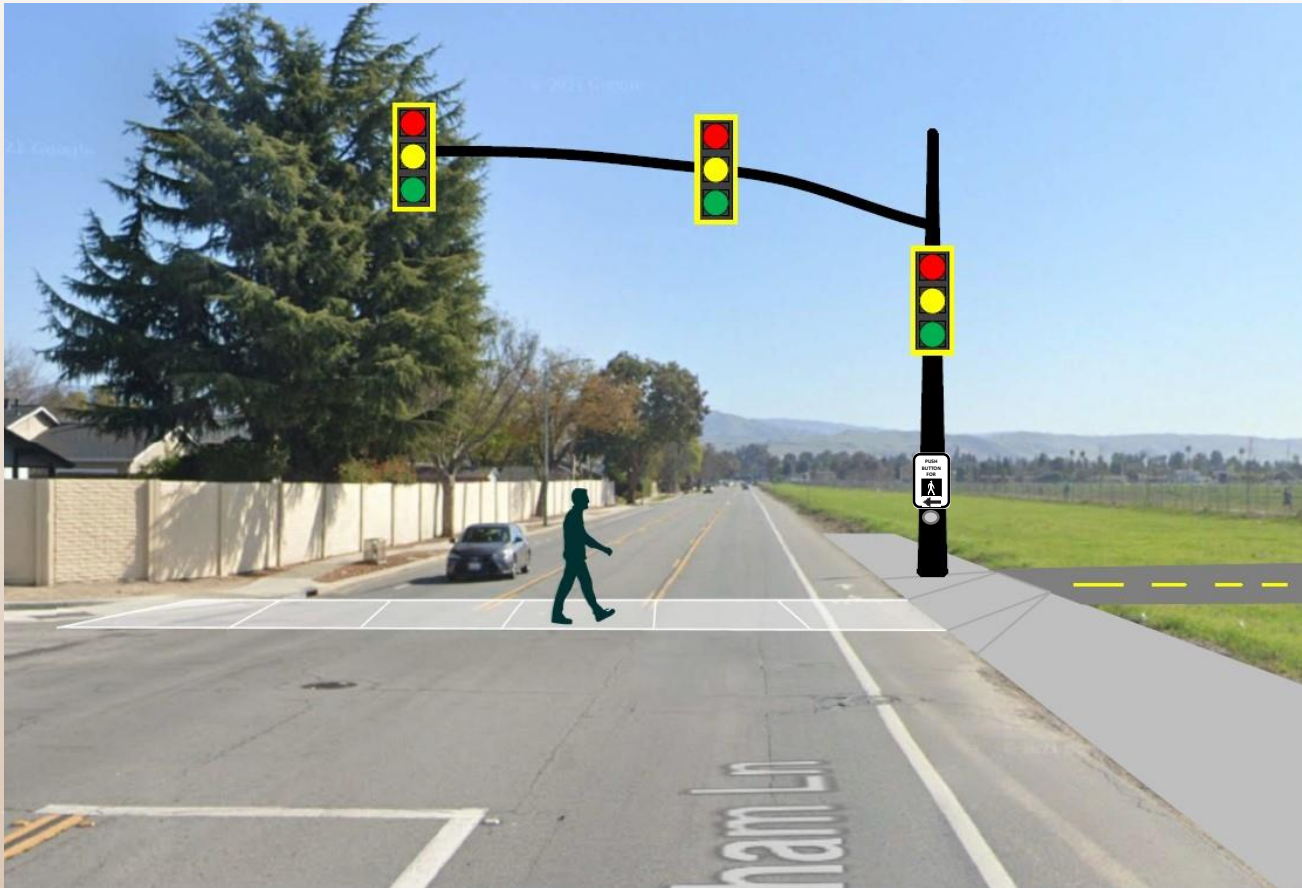
Existing Intersection
