- Report updates to D10 Leadership Coalition quarterly
- Operate autonomously with the members driving the agenda

- Share insights from city departments, legislative process
- Publicly promote the group and opportunities to get involved
- As appropriate, Councilmember Mahan will propose action to city staff / pursue solutions through Council legislative process
