

PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Description: Planned Development Rezoning, Planned Development Permit, and Tentative Map to allow the demolition of one existing single-family residence and associated parking areas, removal of 11 trees, and construction of eight detached, three-story single-family homes on an approximately 0.44-gross acre project site.

The City has performed an environmental review of the project. Based on the review, the City has prepared a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for this project. An MND is a statement by the City that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the project will include mitigation measures that will reduce identified project impacts to a less than significant level. The project site is not present on any list pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code.

The public is welcome to review and comment on the Draft MND. The public comment period for this Draft MND begins on **Tuesday**, **September 21**, **2021 and ends on Friday**, **October 22**, **2021**.
