- Rent-stabilized apartments
- Monitor changes in tenancy
- Monitor changes in rents
- Track allowable rent increases



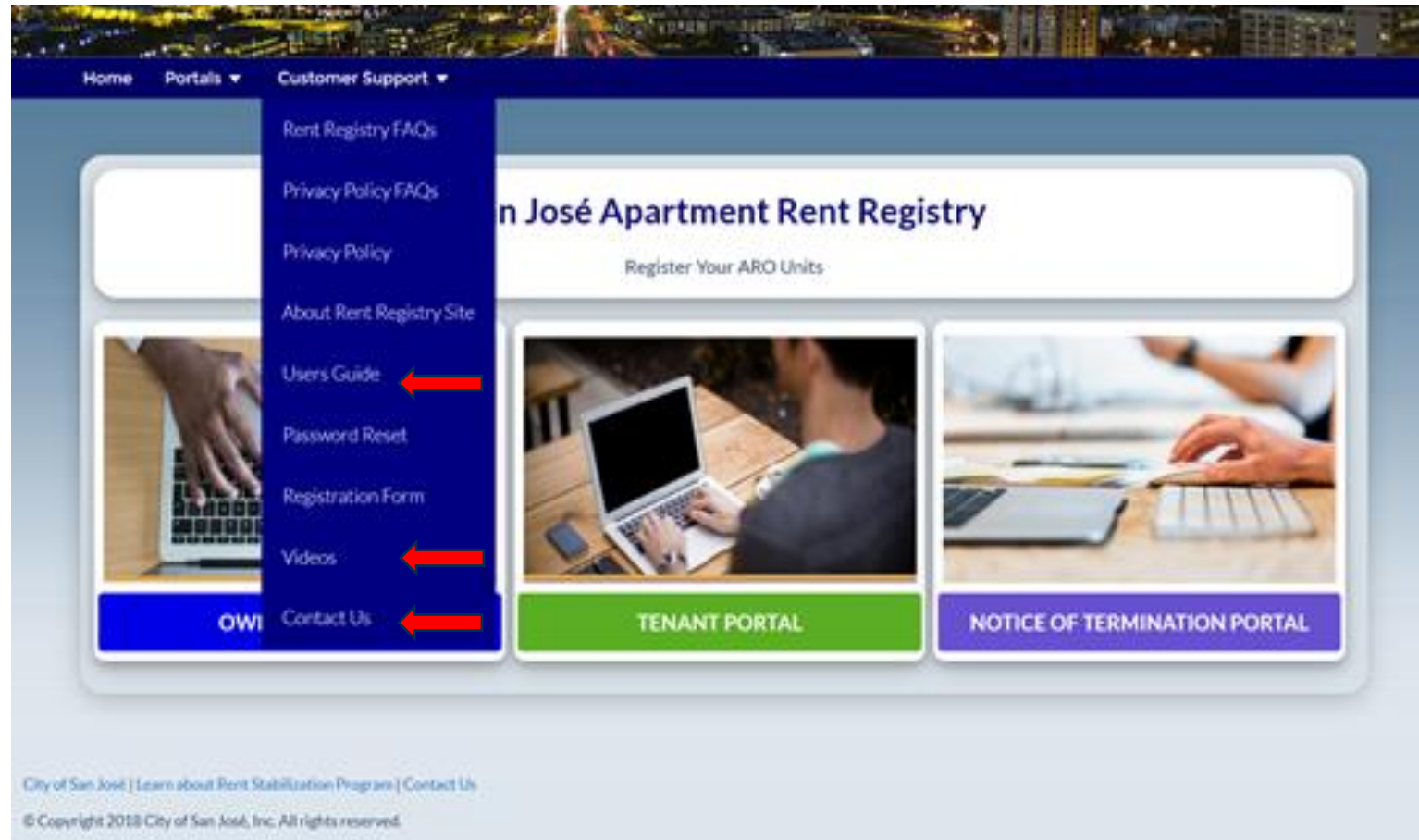


