## **INFORMATION**

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform the City Council of the final membership of the COVID-19 Recovery Task Force (Recovery Task Force).

## **ANALYSIS**

On September 21, 2021, the City Council approved the list of 55 member organizations for the Recovery Task Force, as part of the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 City Roadmap "Build Back Better + Task Force" Initiative.
