# Project Overview

### **Background**

The automobile-focused transportation system in Silicon Valley is reaching its capacity. To accommodate growth in the region in an environmentally sustainable way, transit must improve to be competitive with auto modes to enable car-free living for more people in the area.

### **Overarching Goal**

Create new routes in the Silicon Valley transit system emanating from Diridon Station beginning with SJC Airport connector that are safe, fast, frequent, reliable, offering a high level of rider experience and don't allow mixed-traffic.

# Project Overview

#### **Project**

- Three to four-mile (depending on alignment) transit connection from Diridon Station to SJC Airport that would "integrate Diridon Station and SJC as a single facility from the passenger's perspective"
- P3 Delivery Model driven by schedule & limited public funding
- Alignment to be determined during pre-development stage (PDA) following selection of technological solution and validating its feasibility


#### Timeline

- RFI released in July 2019 with 23 responses.
- RFPQ to be released in Q1 2022.
- City to enter into Pre-development Agreement with successful proposer by mid 2022.
