Proposal

Program/Project Title: Anti-Graffiti and Anti-Litter

Restore one senior maintenance worker to oversee the Alternate Work Program (AWP) that can coordinate with this program or community volunteers throughout the City to do focused abatement. By restoring one senior maintenance worker to oversee the AWP, the City will be able to take advantage of the thousands of volunteers already signed up to continue abating graffiti. Using our human capital will allow the city to engage residents and address the related concerns that come along with graffiti: gangs, violence, vandalism, public safety. This crucial as San José is facing the toughest budget deficit in history and programs like this are what bring us hope and to work together.
