Family Camp at Yosemite campground is located in the Stanislaus National Forest along the Wild and Scenic Tuolumne River. Guests can participate in active games, crafts, nature hikes, self-guided recreational activities, or enjoy a relaxing day at the river. Evening programs include campfire programs, family games, karaoke, and dance parties. This location is perfect for a day trip to Yosemite National Park or a visit one of the many historic goldrush towns.

### *A few tips and reminders to make your stay safe and comfortable:*

- **Check-in time is 2:00 p.m.**
  - Early check-in can be requested but is not guaranteed.
  - If you intend to arrive early and would like to enjoy lunch between 12:30-1:30 p.m., please notify the camp office via email at least one week before your arrival. Additional charges of 12.99 per adult and 8.99 per youth will be added to your reservation and is payable when you check in.
  - Upon check-in, your first included meal will be dinner.
  - Please notify the camp office if your arrival will be later than 9:00 pm.
- **Check out time is 10:00 a.m.**

- Sack lunches are available for order (\$12.00) for those going on a day trip. Lunches must be pre-ordered by 6:00 p.m. the night before through the camp office. Lunches can be picked up at breakfast the following morning.

# Family Camp at Yosemite Rules

- **Quiet Hours are 10:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Please respect your neighbors.**
- No fires, BBQs, gas lanterns, gas stoves, candles or open flames of any kind are allowed on site.
  - Camp staff will host campfires on various nights.
- The Tuolumne County Health Department prohibits smoking indoors or on any of the camp decks. Smoking is allowed behind the dining hall in the designated smoking area.
- **Alcohol consumption is not permitted in the Dining Hall or public areas.**
- Please be “wildlife smart” and protect the wildlife who make their homes here.
  - Please help prevent critter visitation by emptying your trash containers several times a day.
  - **Do not leave food in your tent.** Please secure coolers and other food containers in the trunk of your vehicle.
