### Immigration Legal Assistance and Information

[The Department of Homeland Security \(DHS\) announced that](#) Ukraine has been designated for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for 18 months due to the invasion by Russia. To qualify, Ukrainian nationals must have continuously resided in the United States as of March 1, 2022, and must apply to the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services within 180 days. TPS applicants may also apply for Employment Authorization Documents (EADs) allowing them to work lawfully in the U.S. If you are interested in finding immigration assistance for TPS or other immigration applications, you can search for providers [here](#)
