The Environmental Services Department (ESD) is recruiting for one temporary Chemist to work at the Laboratory in the Watershed Protection Division at the San Jose-Santa Clara Regional Wastewater Facility located at 700 Los Esteros Road, San Jose. The selected candidate for this position will work up to 40 hours per week onsite at the Regional Wastewater Facility (remote work not available) and will typically work either Sunday-Thursday or Tuesday-Saturday, and may occasionally work on holidays. This position has been approved through June 30, 2022 and is proposed to be extended through December 31, 2022, pending budget approval.

### **Responsibilities include but are not limited to:**

- Conducts instrumental and wet chemical analyses on water, wastewater, industrial waste and related samples for specific inorganic and organic substances.
- Performs the routine work and any research related biological, chemical and physical analyses of water, wastewater, industrial waste and related samples.
- Compiles and records laboratory data; provides organization of record keeping and data retrieval; prepares written and verbal reports as requested.

#### Qualifications

#### **Education:**

A Bachelor's degree in chemistry, environmental science, environmental chemistry, or related field.

#### **Experience:**

One (1) year experience working in a laboratory environment.

#### **Employment Eligibility:**

Federal law requires all employees to provide verification of their eligibility to work in this country. Please be informed that the City of San Jose will NOT sponsor, represent or sign any documents related to visa applications/transfers for H1-B or any other type of visa which requires an employer application.

#### **COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement:**
