As a property owner, tenant or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the City of San José Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has received and approved an application package for a new Solid Waste Permit from ATT Recycle dba Leo Recycle per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27CCR), Section 21665 (e). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the City of San José.

<u>Description of Project</u> - The Leo Recycle Facility is an existing Solid Waste Transfer/Processing Facility operating under three different permits; a Medium Volume Construction, Demolition, and Inert (CD/I) Debris Processing Operation (43-AN-0039) to process less than 175 tonnes per day (tpd) of CD/I material, a Chipping, and Grinding Facility/Operation permit (43-AN-0038) to process less than 200 tpd of wood and green material, and an Inert Debris Type A Processing Operation (43-AN-0040) to process less than 1500 tpd of material.

The application package requests approval of the application as a Large Volume Transfer/Processing Facility (43-AN-0042), which would take the place of the current three separate permitted waste facilities designed to take in a new combined total daily limit of 500 tpd.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current solid waste facility permit. The LEA approved the document on 3/25/2022.

<u>Appeals Process Information</u> - Per Public Resources Code §44307, the decision of the LEA may be challenged through an appeals process. To initiate the appeal, contact the City of San José LEA office at (408) 535-7770 to obtain a "Request for Hearing" form.
