Bike Share

• Temporarily removed station @ Delmas and W. Virginia near Biebrach Park (District 6, formerly District 3) is being relocated on W. Virginia at the same corner

Bike Parking

• DOT is looking to install 280 bike racks in the next two months. Please send recommendations of possible locations to jonathan.yuan@sanjoseca.gov.

Active Transportation Program Team management and staffing

• DOT is seeking approval to fill vacancies in the Active Transportation Program (aka "Bike Team")

Micro-mobility/Scooters

- Sidewalk Riding Prohibition Technology Pilot: DOT will be testing sidewalk riding detection/prohibition technology from scooter share companies in DTSJ
 - O BPAC received a Scooter Program presentation at the March Meeting
 - o Please consider filling out the public scooter survey: qrco.de/ScooterSJ
 - Request from Mayor and City council: require technology and messaging to prevent sidewalk riding (link)
- New scooter program manager, Craig Dittmann, joined DOT in April.

Trails Program

- Three Creeks Trail is in construction between Coe and Lonus. The trail segment should be accessible by May 30, 2022.
- The City will begin re-striping and signing the Guadalupe River Trail between Virginia and 880 within the next month.
- Penitencia Creek Trail re-alignment near the BART is completing design to avoid creek erosion. Construction anticipated to begin in May.

- The Parks Dept. ise wrapping up design for Thompson Creek Trail between Quimby and Aborn Court; paving should begin by June.
- Coyote Creek Trail between Mabury and Empire will be finalizing design and permitting next month.

Walk n' Roll/Traffic Safety

- Santa Teresa Elementary launched its Walk n' Roll program with:
 - o Virtual Bike/Ped Safety Assemblies for all students (April 11)
 - o Walk n' Roll Day, including a Walking School Bus of almost 40 children (April 13)
- Sakamoto Elementary held 1st bike rodeo in 2 years (April 2) with about 50 students participating
- Developing high school Walk n' Roll framework for the 2022/2023 school year
- Meeting with school principals throughout June to schedule education and encouragement activities for the 2022/2023 school year

Regional Rail Team

- 7th/Jackson
 - Intersection modification to enhance safety and meet quiet zone requirements for future Warm Springs Partial Quiet Zone
 - o Construction 3/21-3/25, full road closure during work hours
