TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS) - UKRAINE



ARE YOU FROM UKRAINE?

If you are from Ukraine or lived in Ukraine you might qualify for temporary protected status.

WHAT IS TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS):

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is for people who left their home countries because of conflict or natural disasters. The U.S government decides which countries are on the TPS list.

A person with TPS:

- is protected from deportation,
- can work legally in the United States, and
- may travel with permission.

TPS for people from Ukraine ends on October 19, 2023 TPS can be extended. The U.S. government announces extensions and when to sign up again ("re-register").

DO YOU QUALIFY FOR TPS? YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR TPS IF:

- You are from Ukraine or you lived in Ukraine;
- You came to the U.S. by April 11, 2022; and
- You apply for TPS by October 19, 2023.

NOTE: Some trips outside the U.S., crimes, or other problems can disqualify you from TPS.
