Many community groups, neighborhood organizations and nonprofits look to our libraries for space to hold community forums, meetings, and informational sessions to provide services and resources. Libraries hold. In some cases to reserve the room these groups are charged a \$40 fee for reservation. This is cost prohibitive, especially to neighborhood groups who are trying to hold meetings for the first time, or volunteer groups who do not gain from providing resources, but collectively gain by trying to make an impact in their community.

By providing an equity lens to groups who need to make use of this funding, this would ease a financial burden and allow for libraries to continue the great work of being places of community and communal gathering.
