A. Master Parking Rate Schedule

Arian Collen (DOT) presented an overview of proposed program and rate adjustments in the Master Parking Rate Schedule, including the following:

- Introduction of the Commercial Real Estate Parking Program (CREPP)
- Deleting outdated parking permit programs
 - o New Business/Tenant Parking Incentive Program
 - o Class B & C Building Parking Agreements
 - o Business Incentive Free Parking Program for New/Relocating Businesses
- Introduction of global and specific garage permit options and rates
 - o Global Access Permit: \$100/permit/month
 - Eligible at Market Street, 3rd Street, 4th/San Fernando, 2nd/San Carlos
 - o Specific Garage Access: \$125/permit/month
- Adjusting Convention Center Garage daily max rate from \$25 to \$35
- Updating special event rate ranges across portfolio to provide flexibility
