RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: Create a Burglary Investigative Unit

Amount of City Funding Required: \$537,199 in 2012-2013 (\$462,799 personnel; \$74,400 non-personnel)

\$956,766 on-going (\$925,598 personnel; \$31,168 non-personnel_

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.) General Fund

Anticipated Outcomes: Requested funding changes would affect benefits or services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc., as described below: (Use as much space as required.)

Adopting this proposal would restore one sergeant and five police officer positions, which would allow the SJPD to properly respond to the significant recent increase in burglaries.

Anticipated Outcomes: Requested funding changes would affect benefits or services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc., as described below: (Use as much space as required.)

The proposed budget currently recommends repaying the \$2.3 million balance of the loan from the Sewage Treatment Connection Fee Fund. I believe these funds can be put to much better, more critical use. These funds could be used to funds a burglary unit for at least the next two years. If our residents were given the opportunity to choose, there is no doubt that they would prefer to see the funds spent on protecting their homes than on repaying a loan—essentially a loan to ourselves—that does not have to be repaid yet..
