This memorandum responds to a request from Councilmember Constant for a summary report on citywide grants activity.

ANALYSIS

The attachment on the following pages provides summary information on active citywide grants, as reported in the Grant Inventory Listing (Inventory) updated through March 31, 2012 by the Finance Department in coordination with City departments. A grant is considered active until formal close-out with the funding agency. The Inventory is a comprehensive list of all active grants (federal, state and local) received by the City of San José and its departments. The Inventory is maintained by the Finance Department and is regularly updated to include information provided by City departments regarding new grant funds the City of San José is approved to receive from various funding agencies. The information contained in the Inventory is subject to the City's annual Single Audit conducted by the independent certified public accounting firm Macias Gini and O' Connell LLP.

Information (e.g., grant program name, grantor agency, grant amount, etc.) pertaining to each grant is provided by City department. As of the end of March 2012, the City had 251 active grants awarded over several fiscal years totaling more than \$520 million in grant awards, including: \$364 million in federal awards; \$141 million in state awards; and \$15 million in local awards. Grant funds provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development accounted for nearly one-third of the overall federal grant award total, in support of programs such as the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). Pavement maintenance programs, such as Proposition 42 Street Maintenance and Proposition 1B Pavement Maintenance, accounted for nearly half of all state grants awarded to the City.

It is important to note that the Inventory does not include grant programs administered by City departments and grant funds provided to Community Based Organizations to implement programs on behalf of the City.
