SUBJECT: San José Public Art's Public Artist Roster (Multi-Year, Multi-Project) of pre-

qualified artists for use with multiple projects

RECOMMENDATION

Receive the report on the artist selection for the San José Public Art's (SJPA) Artist Roster (Multi-Year, Multi-Project) of pre-qualified artists for use with multiple projects for up to five years.

BACKGROUND

The use of a pre-approved roster of artists is a common practice across the public art field because it provides a number of important efficiencies in both cost, time requirements and labor, for all involved. This is because the process of developing and managing a "Request for Qualifications" (RFQ) process is very labor-intensive, time consuming and costly and for artists, submitting for each project can be considerable work. This can be particularly important when there are a high number of projects that need to move forward and limited staff to manage them and for artists who would like to be considered for multiple projects.

The roster is a pool of artists that has been vetted by a panel of community stakeholders and local arts professionals. Artists in the roster may be may be considered for a wide range of upcoming projects; selection for specific projects will align to the processes framed in Public Art Next!, San José Public Art Program (SJPA) Council-approved master plan. Staff brings forward a group of artists they identify as viable for a particular project. That project will have a stakeholder group that will review and select an artist to recommend for each project. As allowed, there can be some variations on this process.

SJPA has previously used a roster to support project delivery and SJPA has had an active pre-approved roster of muralists since 2017. Inclusion in the roster does not guarantee a commission and it does not preclude artists from applying and being selected for other public art commissions with the City.

ANALYSIS

SJPA has many upcoming projects in the coming five years as a result of the City's implementation of Measure T funded capital projects and due to partnerships with other agencies and other factors; these include transit projects with Valley Transit Authority, fire stations, community centers, storm water facilities located in residential neighborhoods and more. Use of the roster of pre-qualified artists will enable the SJPA team to be timely in addressing the needs of these projects, while also providing a range of efficiencies for both the team as well as for artists. Use of the roster means there doesn't need to be a separate call for each project, saving the staff significant cost and time, and it relieves the burden from the artists from having to prepare submittals for each of the City's public art RFQs.

SJPA released this RFQ on February 26, 2022 on CaFE, the online platform that is widely used for artist calls. The CaFE platform is free for artists to use, is user-friendly and effectively supports the review process for panelists to review and rate artist submittals. Artists living and working in the United States

were eligible to submit entries. The call was open through May 4, 2022. At the time it closed, 297 submittals were received.

A five-member panel of artists and arts professionals (see detail in Public Outreach, below) was formed to review and rate all 297 applications. Staff reviewed the panel's ratings and 219 artists were selected for inclusion in the 2022-2027 Artist Roster. These artists work in a wide range of media however this RFQ excluded artists who are solely muralists from being considered as SJPA will issue a separate call for mural artists soon. It also did not include artists whose media is primarily technology-based work as those public art opportunities are generally for specialized art opportunities and will have their own artist calls.

The RFQ also provided provisions allowing SJPA to update the roster during the roster's five-year duration if deemed necessary.

PUBLIC OUTREACH

While the RFQ was open to artists who live and work in the United States, there was focused outreach to artists living in San José and Northern California. In addition to outreach done via the CaFE platform, outreach for this RFQ was extensive. It included boosted posts by SJPA on social media, posts by the California Arts Council and by Americans for the Arts on their artist notification pages, and by other prominent public art organizations that artists follow. It also included notices about this RFQ opportunity distributed by our affiliate programs to their artist lists across the northern California region. SJPA sent notices and reminders out via Constant Contact to its own artist lists, and also to the more than 360 registrants of our recent Demystifying Public Art webinar series which reached a lot of emerging public artists. Follow up was done to ensure that San José artists were aware of the opportunity. Through these combined efforts notices about this RFQ reached more than 2000.

The review panel reflected a high level of diverse cultural representation and consisted of:
