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

- **Lower transitional heights** in old residential area edges, open spaces, and historic resources due to concerns of overshadowing, ruining mountain views, privacy, temperature change. (51)
- Proposed building heights are too high due to pandemic, overcrowding and airport concerns
 (39)
- Transportation Concerns: need more parking, density will cause traffic, and people won't use public transportation (11)
- Keep 2014 plan heights (5)
- Let market decide how tall to build (2)

- Support staff recommendations, particularly the transitional residential heights (15)
- Developers must pay impact fee to build affordable housing (2)


Somewhat too low and far too low






Which of staff's initial ideas for the Diridon Station Area and/or Downtown Transportation plans are most exciting to you, if any? Check all that apply.






Q13 Assuming there is a limited amount of subsidy available for affordable housing, which is more important to you?

Histogram of Housing Tradeoff







Rank the following ideas in the order that is most important to you to increase job training and educational opportunities.










Q21 Do you work or go to school in San José?



Q22 Sex/gender




What is your age range?


Do you rent or own the home you live in?


Race/Ethnicity of Survey Resondents






Q27 Which of the presentations did you watch prior to completing these survey questions? Check all that apply.


