On Safety

- When Cindy was on City Council, San Jose had 201 more officers⁶ than it does today. As Mayor, she will hire more officers faster & cut response times. San Jose Police Officers support Cindy for Mayor.
- Cindy is working to increase mental health & substance abuse services between the county and city, further addressing root causes of crime.

On Homelessness

- As Supervisor, Cindy helped house over 20,000 homeless individuals⁷ & has authored a strategy to end family homelessness in 2.5 years.⁷
- As Supervisor, Cindy Chavez has voted to increase detoxification service with a goal of serving over 700 people each year.8
- Matt Mahan's solution to house the homeless has been proven not to work. He continues to prioritize quick fixes to long term problems by spending \$40 million⁵ to build temporary and transitional housing — which recycles homeless people back onto our streets.

On Financial Management

- In 2019, Cindy helped save 451 hospital beds & 2 hospitals from bankruptcy. These hopitals were critical in helping our residents during COVID-19.
- Cindy oversaw an \$11.5 Billion Budget as President of the Board of Supervisors and successfully balanced the budget.¹⁰
- At the same time Cindy saved our hospitals, Mahan's social media company, Brigade, was sold. Reports cited "incredibly weak leadership team, abhorrent HR practices, and lavish perks such as free massages and unlimited time off." 3
