MEETING SUMMARY

COVID-19 Recovery Task Force Update

Carlos Velazquez and Aurelia Bailey shared a recap of the Task Force's Community Resource Fair on August 20, 2022 at Seven Trees Community Center. The event connected individuals, families, and business owners in San Jose with existing recovery resources offered by the City and community partners. Counting registrations and walk-ins, approximately 500 people attended, primarily residents living in zip codes most impacted by the pandemic: 95111, 95122, 95127, 95112, and 95116.

Staff shared the remaining Task Force meetings scheduled are on October 13 and November 10 and will focus on finalizing the recommendations and budget allocations that will be going to City Council on December 6.

Task Force member updates:

Kyra Kazantzis of Silicon Valley of Nonprofits shared that they will be hosting a series of virtual Nonprofit Candidate Forums. For a list of the forums, visit the SVCN website.

Monique Melchor of work2future shared that in partnership with San José Works, they are hosting the San José Career Expo on Friday, September 23, 2022 at the South Hall of McEnery Convention Center.
