<u>Documents Filed:</u> Proposed Abatement Order and Notice of Public Hearing dated October 24, 2022

<u>Action:</u> Code Enforcement Inspector Brigitte Villagomez gave testimony. She provided a summary of the inspections and violations at the subject property. The Property Owner failed to meet the requirements of the Compliance Order and continued to be unresponsive to the many attempts to contact by the inspector to discuss the property violations.

Property owner: No Show

Upon a motion by Commissioner Kenny, second by Commissioner Williamson and carried (5-1-0) unanimmously to adopt a resolution confirming the report from the Director

Motion the city has very clearly demonstrated that violations occurred as enumerated in our report and the chronology shows that we can't really expect anything from the Owner given that there are multiple warning letters, seven citation and inspections notices that have gone ignored. I would move that we adopt the staff recommendations in their entirety including that if the above mention hazards and violations are not removed within 10 calendar days of the date of service of the board resolutions in this matter, the abatement shall be performed by a city approved contractor or service providers and cost of removal charged to the property owner should be billed following the completion of the work and paid in full within (30) days of the billing date.
