
## About the Park

The 2.5-acre park site would be located along Seely Avenue, just north of Montague Expressway. This is currently referred to as the "Montague and Seely" park site. However, this is a working title until a permanent name is selected. This future park site would result from the approval of a 22-acre mixed-use development project that is currently under review with the Planning Department. The proposed development project includes development of 1,470 residential units, approximately 52,000 square-feet of retail space, and a new public park. However, this meeting will focus on the park design and naming.



## Background

This will be the first of two community meetings regarding the potential future park site. During this first community meeting, the community will hear a presentation about the park site and have an opportunity for feedback and comment. After the meeting concludes, community members will have an opportunity to participate in an <u>online survey</u> to provide input on potential name suggestions and offer feedback on conceptual designs. The purpose of the community meeting is to focus on the new park site. Planning Department staff will provide a very brief overview of the mixeduse development project.
