

SPECIAL PARK USE PERMIT CATEGORIES

PERMIT	SPECIAL EVENT	ACTIVITY
DEFINITION	A celebration of the diversity of the San José community that involves a non-routine activity which has an impact on community resources, may involve a large number of people and requires permits or additional planning, preparation and mitigation.	A community based activity that only requires minimal park resources and other permits.
FEES	See Special Event Fee Matrix	Application Fee + Activity Fee (\$100 - \$1,500)
EXAMPLES	Breast Cancer Walk, Cinco de Mayo, Italian Family Festa	Egg Hunt, Community Gathering

PERMIT	ASSEMBLY	FILMING/PHOTOGRAPHY
DEFINITION	The right to express information, ideas, and opinions free of government restriction based on content and subject only to reasonable limitations.	Digital or film recording of a visual image or sound recording by a person, business, or other entity for a market audience, such as for a documentary, television or feature film, advertisement, or similar project.
FEES	Application Fee	Application Fee + Filming/Photography Fee (\$40 - \$600 or by agreement \$600+)
EXAMPLES	Political Propositions, Education Reform	Student Filming, Motion Picture, Magazine Advertisement

***Any formal organized group planning any organized activity within a City of San José park must obtain a permit.**
